BT = Baum Trophy summer league. LC = Lawrance Cup (for Div 1). **FC = Finchley Cup** (for Div 2/3). W3 are in Finchley Cup Final & W1 are in Lawrance Cup Final both against & at Barking. W3 in FC comprise all players (except Wanstead Juniors who are cup tied) below S rating 1920. W1 in LC comprise all non-junior players. Wanstead Baum trophy teams reflect perceived opposition strength.

EK=Essex Knockout and Plate. First round matches (**Wanstead A** are seeded) are to take place by 8 July. First round losers continue in the Plate competition. Wanstead A & B (below R rating 1825) cannot meet until the Finals, though in theory C (below R rating 1590) could meet A in the semis; a player can only play for 1 team. Round 2 will comprise a single match for Wanstead C whether in the Plate or the Knockout to be played by 29 July, with Wanstead A & B having byes into the semis to be played by 3 September. Knockout and Plate finals at start of new season.
